Project Description: The Pasadena City Council found that the establishment of a Preferential Permit Parking Program district boundary (District "LC") is necessary and prudent to alleviate the direct impact of non-local parking and that expansion of the preferential parking district is consistent with procedures and the ordinance. The establishment of District "LC" will include the following streets pursuant to Chapter 10.41 of the Pasadena Municipal Code:

- 1. Both sides of La Canada Verdugo Road
- 2. Both sides of Vista Laguna Terrace between La Canada Verdugo Road and 2445 Vista Laguna Terrace
- 3. Both sides of Arroyo Boulevard between La Canada Verdugo Road and Woodbury Road

Reason why project is exempt: This project has been determined to be categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15301, Class 1, Existing Facilities. Class 1 exempts from environmental review the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical

equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of the existing use. The proposed project consists of a minor alteration of the existing street network to establish the Preferential Permit Parking Program District "LC". No expansion of the street network is proposed. Furthermore, the existing streets will not physically change due to this program and their primary function will remain the same.
