A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES AUTHORIZE AND ORDER THE CONSOLIDATION OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF THE CITY OF PASADENA WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018, AND REQUESTING THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK PROVIDE CERTAIN SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pasadena has called a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is submitting to the qualified voters of the City of Pasadena a sales tax measure to implement a local $\frac{3}{4}\phi$ sales tax and an advisory ballot question pertaining to the use of funds generated by the proposed sales tax to support Pasadena public schools; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, and that within the City, the precincts, polling places, and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk canvass the returns of the City's General Municipal Election, and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to secure the consent and order of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to effect such consolidation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pasadena as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the California Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of the City's General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, to submit two City measures to the voters of the City of Pasadena.

SECTION 2. The local sales tax measure is to appear on the ballot in substantially the following form:

Pasadena Infrastructure/Community Essential Services Protection Measure Shall an ordinance be adopted to maintain essential City of Pasadena services such as fire, police, paramedics, emergency service/response times; keep fire stations open; improve neighborhood and school safety, repair streets/sidewalks; address homelessness; maintain after-school programs/senior services, and other general fund services, by establishing a $\frac{3}{4}\%$ sales tax providing approximately \$21,000,000 annually until ended by voters; requiring audits and all funds locally controlled? SECTION 3. The advisory ballot measure is to appear on the ballot in substantially the following form:

ADVISORY VOTE ONLY: If Pasadena voters approve a local sales tax measure, should the City use 2/3rds of the measure's annual revenue to maintain essential City of Pasadena services such as fire, police, paramedics, emergency service/response times; keep fire stations open; improve neighborhood and school safety; repair streets/sidewalks; address homelessness; maintain after-school programs/senior services; with the remaining 1/3rd of the measure's revenue going to support Pasadena public schools? SECTION 4. The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and to certify the same to the City Council of the City of Pasadena at the time and in the manner provided by law. The vote requirement for passage of the two City measures shall be a majority of votes cast (50% plus 1) for each measure. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

SECTION 5. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

SECTION 6. The City of Pasadena recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation, and the City agrees to reimburse the County for all expenses incurred for services requested by this resolution.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.
