Message to Mayor Tornek and Pasadena City Councilmembers:

As Anne Lansing, the City's Housing Assistance Officer, stated: "Without housing to place people in, outreach teams cannot end homelessness for people living on the streets." Between July 2017 and February 2018, 221 community members have been reached through street outreach, and 23 people have been permanently housed. That is only a 10% success rate.

As one of several housing strategies, I hope City Council will agree to encourage construction of ADUs:

Support Option #2 (waive residential impact fee): Implement the recommended landlord affordability agreement for the entire time the landlord owns the property. Upon change of ownership, new owners should be assessed residential impact fees if they do not agree to the affordability agreement of the previous owner.

Thank you for addressing this pressing community concern. We need to continue working together to develop multiple strategies to ensure all community members have homes.







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In addition to recommending the staff's proposal, we also ask that the fees for ADUs be lowered across the board in all cases. We feel that the current fee of \$25,000 to \$31,000 for one 600 square foot ADU is "unreasonable, excessive and burdensome" (to use the language of the state law). When you add the City's requirements of architectural plans and additional regulatory requirements, units become extremely expensive to build, and rents must be set at levels out of reach for our community in order to obtain a return on the investment. Therefore, it makes sense to ask that all fees be lowered to affordable rates. Research shows that lower fees can help make ADUs more affordable and help homeowners stay in their homes. Our City is facing a severe housing crisis, with over half of its residents unable to afford rents, which now average over \$2,100 for a one-bedroom apartment. ADUs tend to rent at below average market rate when fees are not excessive. Please allow private homeowners to help alleviate our housing shortage—which is pushing up prices and driving moderate and lower income people out of our City).

In addition to our concern about the fees for ADUs we also care about the city-owned property on the NE corner of Fair Oaks and Orange Grove, Heritage Square South. This property provides us with the opportunity to create another beautiful permanent supportive housing (PSH) like Marv's place pictured below that has won recognition as the best PSH in all of Southern California. In the 2017 homeless count, there were 80 seniors counted among the total of 575. Each year All Saints Church has a memorial service for our homeless neighbors in Pasadena who have died on the street-many of whom are seniors. It is morally wrong to allow this unnecessary tragedy when we have in our power to provide housing. We have the funding, the land, and the need it there, so it makes the most sense to use this property to move those who are living on our streets, especially seniors, into housing.
