SUBJECT: CONFIRM A PURCHASE ORDER AWARD TO REFLECT THE FULL BUSINESS NAME OF ENTITY AS LOS ANGELES TRUCK CENTERS, LLC, DOING BUSINESS AS LOS ANGELES FREIGHTLINER

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Find that the proposed purchase order is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3); and
2. Confirm the prior purchase order award with Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC, doing business as Los Angeles Freightliner, to reflect the full business entity name.

BACKGROUND:

On June 18, 2018, City Council authorized a purchase order with Los Angeles Freightliner for two Autocar Freedom compressed natural gas powered front loading refuse packers for an amount not to exceed \$751,360 for the Department of Public Works. The original agenda report inadvertently did not include the full business entity name. Therefore, a change to the City Council authorization is recommended to reflect the full entity name of Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC, doing business as Los Angeles Freightliner. All other recommendations from the original report remain the same.

The Department of Public Works uses front loading refuse packers to collect mixed waste, yard waste and recyclable materials from more than 1,500 commercial customers on a weekly basis. This purchase is replacing vehicles that have reached the end of their useful life.

COUNCIL POLICY CONSIDERATION:

This action supports the City Council's strategic goal to increase conservation and sustainability.


ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

This contract is exempt from CEQA per section 15061(b)(3), the General Rule. The General Rule can be applied when it can be seen with certainty that the activity will not have a significant effect on the environment. The proposed action will only confirm the full business entity name in the previous council authorization and will not result in any new development or physical changes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact as a result of this action to confirm the prior contract authorization reflecting the full business entity name.
