A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA ADOPTING THE UPDATED SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN (SSMP) PREPARED BY DUDEK, AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CERTIFY AND SUBMIT THE SSMP TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD.

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2006, the California State Water Resources Control Board ("SWRCB") promulgated a waste discharge requirement ("WDR") permit, known as SWRCB Order No. 2006-003, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems ("Order") to regulate sanitary sewer systems. This permit requires local public sewer collection system agencies, referred to as "Enrollees", to develop a Sewer System Management Plan ("SSMP"), which must be self-audited at least every two (2) years and updated or revised and re-certified every five (5) years from the original adoption date by the Enrollee's governing board; and

WHEREAS, all federal and state agencies, municipalities, counties, districts, and other public entities that own or operate sanitary sewer systems greater than one mile in length that collect and/or convey untreated or partially treated wastewater to a publicly-owned treatment facility in the State of California, which includes the City of Pasadena, are required to comply with the terms of the Order pursuant to California Water Code Section 13263; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the WDR, the City of Pasadena submitted a certified SSMP document to the SWRCB for approval prior to May 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City's updated SSMP, dated as of November, 2019, has been prepared by Dudek, has been reviewed by the City's Department of Public Works, and is now ready for approval by the City Council and certification and submittal to the SWRCB and to be made available on the City's website.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pasadena that the Sewer System Management Plan prepared by Dudek, in the form presented to the City Council, is hereby adopted, and the Director of Public Works, as the City's legally responsible official, is hereby authorized and directed to certify and submit said Plan to the SWRCB and to make it available on the City's website.
