

to regularly revise, update, and clean-up service regulations. On November 19, 2018, the City Council approved the staff recommendation to direct the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance to amend PMC Title 13. The proposed amendments would allow the Water and Power Department to efficiently update, revise and implement service regulations.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS:

On November 19, 2018, the City Council found that the proposed action is not a project subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") as defined in Section 21065 of CEQA and Section 15378 of the State CEQA Guidelines and, as such, no environmental document pursuant to CEQA is required for this action.


PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED:
