SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 10, CHAPTERS 10.40, 10.42, 10.44, AND 10.45 REGARDING PARKING METER OPERATIONS

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 10, CHAPTERS 10.40, 10.42, 10.44, AND 10.45 REGARDING PARKING METER OPERATIONS

PURPOSE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

The proposed ordinance will clarify previous ordinance amendments to ensure that departmental responsibilities with respect to parking operations and parking meter technology are reflected in Title 10 of the Municipal Code.

BACKGROUND:

On February 27, 2017 and May 8, 2018, the City Council approved proposed amendments to the Pasadena Municipal Code to align departmental responsibilities with current parking practices. Additional changes are recommended in the proposed ordinance related to car share/ridesharing spaces, and other technical modifications, consistent with current operations.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

Parking regulations are codified within Title 10 of the Pasadena Municipal Code and an ordinance is required to amend Title 10.
