

DIRECTIVE ON THE FUTURE OF THE HAHAMONGNA WATERSHED PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE (HWPAC)

City Council Meeting
October 21, 2019





- Purpose and Function (Section 2.100.120 of the PMC)
 - > Established in 2002 as a thirteen-member (13) committee, the HWPAC is composed of:
 - All nine (9) members of the Recreation and Parks Commission
 - Two (2) members of the Northwest Commission
 - Two (2) members of the Environmental Advisory Commission



- > The committee's purview includes:
 - Review and recommendation of the HWP master plan;
 - Oversight of the preparation of the environmental documents associated with the HWP master plan;
 - Oversight of the construction of the HWP restoration project;
 - Review of revenue and financing proposals to fund the ongoing operations and maintenance of HWP; and
 - Development of a plan for public outreach and community involvement in accomplishing the functions listed above





- Committee members expressed thoughts about the purpose and functions of the committee and difficulties in achieving quorums for committee meetings
- > Concepts explored included:
 - Sun-setting the committee;
 - Using the Recreation and Parks Commission to deliberate on items associated with HWP; and/or
 - Modifying the composition of the HWPAC
- Letter in packet from HWPAC Chair Cindy Schnuelle, requesting a modification to the composition of the HWPAC

City Council to provide direction in response to the Hahamongna Watershed Park Advisory Committee's (HWPAC) proposed modification to the composition of the committee, which is:

- 5 members from Recreation & Parks Commission
- 1 member designated from Environmental Advisory Commission
- 1 member designated from the Northwest Commission
- 2 at-large members of the community

City Council may choose to take any of the following actions:

- 1) Adopt the HWPAC recommendation and direct the City Attorney's Office to modify PMC 2.100.120;
- 2) Leave the current structure of the HWPAC unchanged;
- 3) Sunset the HWPAC; or
- 4) Provide staff with alternative recommendation(s) regarding the composition and/or purpose and functions of HWPAC
