I have been following the situation on North Madison for several months and have been surprised to see that the Council has given more weight to the claims of the project developer than to the legitimate opposition of Pasadena citizens. My opposition concerns the removal of trees without the proper permit and in violation of the tree removal ordinance.

Pasadena is a rapidly developing city. But there is growing concern that in the process of building needed housing, much of it high-end, the City is overlooking the need for open space, trees and, where possible, set-backs such as this project had and could continue to provide. As Climate Change is pounding at the door of cities around the world where trees have been removed to make way for development, always with disastrous consequences, Pasadena should stand firm behind its carefully conceived tree ordinance that protect one of our most valuable natural resources, our tree canopy. Whether on public or private land, our trees should be protected because of their important role in absorbing carbon dioxide and purifying our heavily polluted air. All that is required is for our Council to stand firmly behind our tree ordinance and not, once again, appease a developer. Enough is enough!
