Section 404. - VACANCY—APPOINTMENT.

If a vacancy occurs in the office of Mayor, the Vice Mayor shall assume the duties of the office of Mayor until the office shall be filled at the next general municipal election. The assumption of the duties of the Mayor shall not require that the Vice Mayor relinquish his or her seat as a Councilmember elected or appointed from a district. If a vacancy occurs among any other members of the City Council, the remaining members shall within 75 days after such occurrence appoint a qualified resident voter of the unrepresented district who shall hold office until the office is filled at the next general municipal election. If the City Council cannot agree on one person to fill the vacancy, the replacement shall be chosen by lot.

Nothing herein provided shall limit the power of the City Council to provide by ordinance for the continuity of the City Government in the event of war, enemy-caused disaster or common accident in which a majority of the members of the City Council are killed, missing or injured so as to be unable to perform their duties.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO FILL A VACANCY BY APPOINTMENT FOR A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL, DISTRICT 5

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Pasadena City Charter, Section 404, the City Council of the City of Pasadena will accept applications from qualified registered voters residing in City Council District 5 to fill a vacancy by appointment created by the resignation of Councilmember Victor M. Gordo, which occurred on December 7, 2020 as a result of his successful election and start of term as Mayor of Pasadena.

The term of service for the appointment to the Council District 5 seat is from the date of appointment to December 12, 2022.

In addition to a completed application, applicants must circulate a nomination petition and gather a minimum of 25 qualified signatures from registered voters living in and registered in District 5. Nomination petitions and application materials are available in the City Clerk's Office, and will be issued subject to confirmation of eligibility. Applicants must hand-deliver all completed materials no later than 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 14, 2021 to the Office of the City Clerk. No postmarks, email submissions, or faxes will be accepted. There is a \$25.00 filing fee due at the time applications and nomination petitions are filed.

To be considered for the position, those applicants invited to participate must also attend a special meeting of the City Council in February 2021 for the purposes of a public interview by the full City Council. The date and time of the meeting has yet to be determined and further information will be provided after all applications are received.

Presentations by applicants at the special meeting will be limited to six (6) minutes, followed by a question and answer period conducted by the City Council on each applicant's qualifications. The effective date of service for the newly appointed City Councilmember representing District 5 will begin on the day of appointment following the administration of the Oath of Office by the City Clerk.
