The City of Pasadena will use PLHA funds for the following activities: 1) to provide operating reserves subsidy to existing permanent supportive housing developments serving Extremely Low Income households; 2) to make down payment assistance loans to Moderate and Workforce Income households; 3) to provide rental assistance to households at risk of experiencing homelessness; and 4) to provide supplemental funding to the City's upcoming ADU pilot program, which will provide short-term loans for the predevelopment and construction of ADUs that are rented exclusively to the City's rental assistance clients, and which will help low-income owners rehabilitate existing ADUs.

§302(c)(4)(B) Provide a description of the way the Local government will prioritize investments that increase the supply of housing for households with incomes at or below 60 percent of Area Median Income (AMI).

The operating reserves will be committed to permanent supportive housing developments, where residents earn little or no income. The rental assistance will be provided to households who earn no more than 50% of AMI. Finally, the City intends to require new construction ADU landlords to rent to the City's rental assistance clients, so all of these ADUs will be rented to housholds earning less than 60% of AMI.

The Plan is consistent with several of the goals included in the City's Local Housing Element, including: 1) Facilitating a mix of household income and affordability levels in residential projects; 2) Facilitating the development of affordable housing through financial assistance; 3) Supporting the provision of rental assistance for residents earning lower incomes; and 4) Encouraging the development of Workforce Housing Opportunities.

The City has already developed guidelines for the ADU Pilot Program and expects to launch this program in Fall 2020/Winter 2021.
