Mayor Tornek & Councilmembers,

Hathaway-Sycamores urges you to adopt the Housing Department's recommendations for the proposed developments by the Bridge Housing Corporation and the Salvation Army.

As the lead agency for the Youth Coordinated Entry System in SPA 3, Hathaway-Sycamores offers an array of mental health and housing programs for homeless young adults. Supported by different LA County Departments, City of Pasadena and philanthropic donors, our programs include TILP, THP Plus, Rapid Rehousing, and Homeless Prevention. We support the proposed developments in Agenda Item #4 because more Permanent Support Housing is needed in the fight to end homelessness in Pasadena. According to Pasadena's 2020 Homeless Count, the percentage of homeless seniors increased by 27% compared to 2019. The 2020 Count also revealed that the disproportionate number of homeless are single adults. While Pasadena has made significant investment in services and projects in the last decade, this data reveals the need to remain steadfast in strengthening the entire Continuum of Care, including Permanent Support Housing. This becomes more urgent due to the current economic recession that will put more people at risk of homelessness.

In closing, we strongly support the proposed development projects by Bridge Housing Corporation and Salvation Army.
