Our City must stand with hotel workers who are the backbone of our city's successful hospitality industry. If the City desires to continue to be a beacon for entertainment and play - our hotels are instrumental and that is why you must better serve hotel workers. Local hotels (including the popular Langham) have decided to fire longstanding employees and what will happen is that as they reopen slowly, they will replace former senior staff with entry level new hires that they can pay less! This is incredibly unjust. The City of Pasadena can do something has have the cities of Glendale, Santa Monica, Long Beach and Los Angeles. Remember - ONLY ONE hotel in Pasadena is under a collective bargaining unit which means every other hotel employee is vulnerable to being fired for no other reason other than these businesses want to hire new employees at a lower wage!
