I'd like to register my extreme displeasure and disgust related to Mayor Terry Tornek's irresponsible decision to leave for Senegal on a ceremonial "sister city" trip March 3 just as the COVID-19 epidemic was about to hit Pasadena. The day he left, Pasadena recorded its first coronavirus death and while he was gone, the World Health Organization declared the virus a Pandemic. Most disturbing, Mayor Tornek didn't even phone in during the City Council's special (emergency) meeting on March 10, making him the only elected member of the City Council recorded as missing crucial votes to ratify an emergency declaration, as well as to provide relief to vulnerable citizens. His lack of judgment is appalling, as is his reluctance or refusal to offer any apology. To prevent future occurrences of this type, I call on the City Council to enact a new ordinance requiring compulsory attendance by the the Mayor and City Councilmembers for all special meetings at which an emergency declaration is proposed or for regular meetings when an emergency declaration is in effect.
