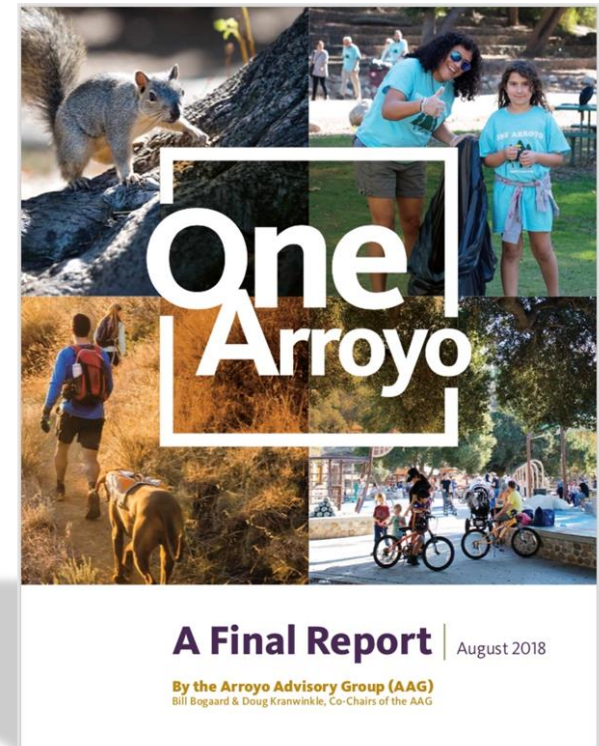

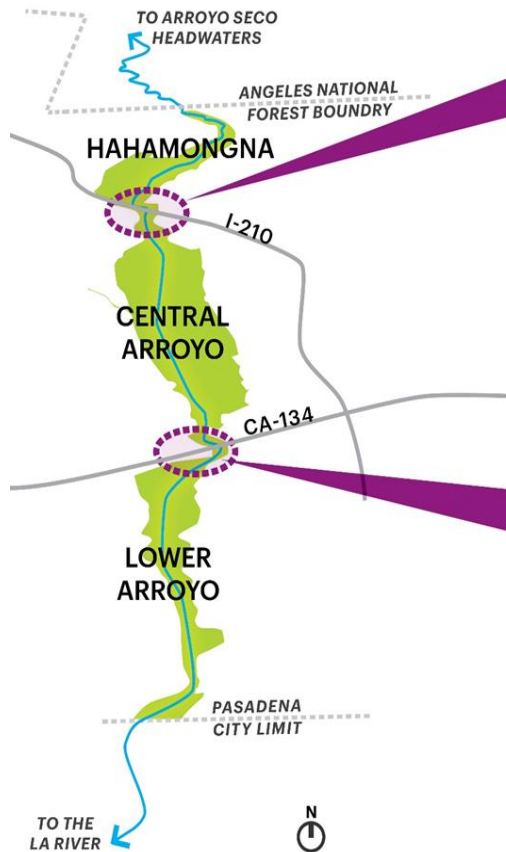
Background

- The One Arroyo Foundation was formed in 2019 as a recommendation by the Arroyo Advisory Group (AAG).
- The AAG was tasked with:
 - > Developing a cohesive vision for the Arroyo Seco
 - > Examining ways to address significant deferred maintenance and fund improvements, despite limited funds

- The AAG's Final Report also recommended two trail demonstration projects.
- In June 2019, the City and the One Arroyo Foundation entered into a M.O.U. to establish a contractual relationship through which the demonstration projects would be funded and undertaken in the Arroyo.

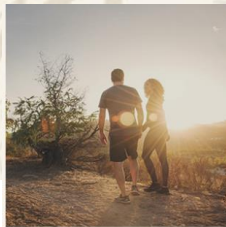


One Arroyo Foundation Updates

- The One Arroyo Foundation has formed a 16-member Board of Directors.
- The Board's initial fundraising efforts has netted sufficient funds to begin the design phase of the trail demonstration projects.
- The Foundation issued a RFP for design work and the firm is expected to begin background work in Q4 2020.

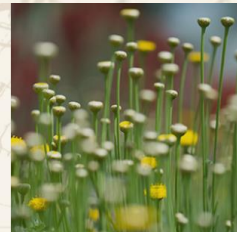

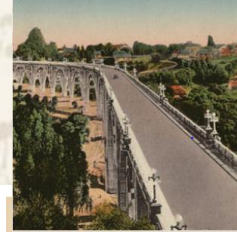

Future Project Construction Fundraising

Public-Private Partnership:

- The Foundation will continue to privately raise funds from both private and public (non-city) sources.
- Through the Foundation's efforts, the City was awarded \$500k in Proposition A funds from the County of Los Angeles towards environmental review and construction.
- The City may consider supplemental funding through its regular budgetary process.



Future Environmental Review Requirements

- Neither the staff report nor this presentation constitute an approval or commitment to a construction project.
- Prior to any construction of the projects, and as the projects progress through preliminary design, environmental review will be required when their potential environmental effects may be known and analyzed.
- Costs related to the environmental review will be funded by a portion of the Proposition A funds and Residential Impact Funds previously earmarked for these projects.
