Recommendation



It is recommended that the City Council, as part of a public hearing process in compliance with California Elections Code Section 21627.1, take the following actions:

(1) Find that the proposed action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), the Common Sense Exemption that CEQA only applies to projects that have the potential to have a significant effect on the environment;

(2) Receive and file the Redistricting Task Force's recommended redistricting plan ("Redistricting Plan"), map, and related demographic data sheet (Attachment A - "Recommended Redistricting Plan approved October 30, 2021 by the Redistricting Task Force");

(3) Receive public comment on the Redistricting Plan, and any public input/testimony regarding the composition of one or more council districts;

(4) Approve the Redistricting Plan as submitted by the City's Redistricting Task Force; and

(5) <u>Close the public hearing, approve the Redistricting Task Force recommendation, and conduct</u> <u>first reading</u> of "An Ordinance of the City of Pasadena Amending Chapter 1.20 ("Election Districts") of the Pasadena Municipal Code" codifying the Recommended Plan as submitted.
