Dear ACCJC Commissioners:

This Third Party Comment regards IVB.1a: Board and Administrative Organization, Standard IV: Leadership Governance; PCC's 2014 Accreditation Self-Evaluation of Pasadena Area Community College District.

This was originally hand-delivered to the Pasadena City College [PCC] Board of Trustees [BOT] at a regular meeting circa December 1991 AD [about one-quarter of a century] ago in the Circadian in the CC Building.

This was then emailed to Trustee Marshall Lewis on 26 August 2014. Care of copies were sent to the Clerk, Pasadena City College Board of Trustees [Trustee Linda Wah, Trustee Area #5 (San Marino, South Pasadena and eastward)], Trustee Area #4 William E. Thomson [past Mayor & Council Member of the City of Pasadena], Acting Superintendent Robert B. Miller and Crystal A. Kollross [Director, Institutional Effectiveness and Planning]. I also emailed Dr. Anthony Fellow [Trustee Area #7 (Arcadia, generally speaking)].

On October 13, 2014 as part of Accreditation Self-Evaluation, I submitted under Standard IV: Leadership Governance, specifically IVB.1a: Board and Administrative Organization to the Interim Dean [Instructional Support] Matthew Jordan. On that email of 13 October 2014, I gave a care of copy to the President of the Associated Students, Inc. Mr. Jordyn Orozco. Mr. Jordyn Orozco has been most recently employed or volunteered by the Pasadena Area Community College District in August 2016. Messrs. Jordyn Orozco and Matthew Jordan never responded to a single piece of correspondence sent by me.

In late 1991, I read the pertinent census tracts which created TWO [2] majority-minority influence Trustee Areas WITHIN the Pasadena Unified School District: A) Western Altadena based Trustee Area and B) The Chicano-Hispano-Latino [CHL] Interstate 210 Freeway Corridor Trustee Area. That was about twenty-five [25] years ago. The CHiLL American [Chicano-Hispano-indigenous-Ladino-Latino] populace growth and development continues to expand. The evolution of these two proposed Trustee Areas was organic and predicated on my understanding and comprehension of the applicable California and USA Constitutional precepts of the popular sovereignty found in the First [1st] Amendment [Freedom of Assembly & Freedom of Speech & Right of Petition and the Magna Carta Libertatum (the Great Charter of the Liberties-1215 AD) and the Tenth [10th] and the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

The numerical count read into the minutes justified the creation of TWO "majority-minority" influence Trustee Areas among the SEVEN member Governing Board of Pasadena Area Community College District [the "DISTRICT" or "PACCD"]. In my reading of the filings which would be the bases of **Shaw v. Reno**, 509 U.S. 630 (1993) decision by Justice Sandra Day O'Conner the racially and ethnically diverse proposed Trustee Areas for 1991 fit perfectly with the trend of history to enfranchise those persons which had been

prevented and excluded to the full flowering of representative democracy in the HOME of the BRAVE and the land of the FREE.

O, thus be it ever when freemen shall stand,
Between their lov'd homes and the war's desolation;
Blest with vict'ry and peace, may the heav'n-rescued land
Praise the Pow'r that hath made and preserv'd us a nation!
Then conquer we must, when our cause is just,
And this be our motto: "In God is our trust"
And the star-spangled banner in triumph shall wave
O'er the land of the free and the home of the brave!

Mr. Ruben R. Enriquez and Mrs. Maria [de los Angeles] Marquez de Enriquez sacrificed too greatly to provide this person with a magnificent education. The nuns of the Holy Names of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph taught this Pasadena-conceived, raised and educated man the civic lessons which he holds dear today. The Franciscan OFM's of La Canada-Flintridge fortified that young man and continued to mold him into a gentlemen [a Golden Knight]. All because Mr. & Mrs. Enriquez bequeath and endowed this person in the care of truly great individuals for his education through long toiling hours, days, weeks, months, years and decades in the esprit de corps of American entrepreneurialism. At a fever pitch that their struggles provided an entry into the Great Middle Class which is the backbone of American Freedom and brought prosperity to their great grandchildren. Five generations of my family are of the City of Pasadena, this is my only Village which claims my fidelity and loyalty.

Three generations of my family are LANCERS graduates. This is my Community College; this is my Pasadena City College. So, to witness the continuing disenfranchisement of so loyal a people is reprehensible. I have a deep sense of place, the rich soil of the City of Pasadena and Pasadena Unified School District. These are all within the geographical entity called "Pasadena Area Community College District." This is my cherished City and my adored Alma Mater.

I now present to the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges the SEVEN Trustee Areas proposed in 1991 for their perusal. The nineteen ninety-nine [1991] proposed plan by yours truly held as its ideal: population equality by TOTAL POPULATION [ONE PERSON, ONE VOTE of Reynolds v. Sims, 377 U.S. 533 (1964) and Baker v. Carr, 369 U.S. 186 (1962)] and the Voting Rights Act of 1965. Half a century has pasted and yet PACCD clings to a pre-Civil Rights mentality of a restrictive and exclusionary mode of living.

Exclosed you will find the 1991 AD Seven (7) Trustee Area map for the Pasadena Area Community College District. This was presented in the Circadian Room at regular meeting of the Board of Trustees in 1991, nearly 23 years ago. At the time, National Demographics, Inc. based the Trustee Areas by census tracts. I also gave the population figures. I created two (2) majority-minority influence seats among the Trustee Areas within the Pasadena Unified School District sub-component of PACCD by rearranging those PUSD census tracts with those of La Canada Unified

Trustee Areas five (5), six (6) and seven (7) were untouched. They were drawn by National Demographics, Inc. 1 did not contest those census tracts of the southern area of PACCD. Nor did I disrupt those arrangements. NDI were amiable.

My creation for the four (4) Only two (2) of the current seven (7) Trustees are incumbent today. They are Trustees Dr. Jeanette Mann and Trustee Mr. John Martin. most northern Trustee Areas were within ½ of one percent of the ideal size for trustee areas based on the April 1, 1990 census.

Dear Dr. Beno:

The contents of this letter includes the whole of the fax and then email of 13 September 2016: "0913 Seven Trustee Areas 1991 pp18" which eighteen pages long as a Third Party Comment. The good offices of the ACCJC acknowledged receipt.

I thought it appropriate to include you in on this information since the Pasadena Area Community College District [PACCD] will discuss H1: "Action Item Recommended for Approval, 1] Resolution for Consolidation of Future Board of Trustees Election with the Statewide Election etc.", on its December 14, 2016 meeting.

Because the underlying Trustee Areas of the BOT are gerrymandered the Chicano \* Hispano \* indigenous \*Ladino \* Latino [CHiLL] Americans start at a competitive disadvantage in electing someone of their own choosing; in the highest CHiLL American by Citizen Voting Age Population [CVAP] Trustee Area is only in the high 30's percentile. That is horrendous situation, it means that in the highest probability Trustee Area [TA] within PACCD, CHiLL\* Americans will be outvoted by approximately two to one [2 to 1].

In correspondence already sent to the ACCJC and to the BOT PACCD, I have already demonstrated that one Trustee Area [TA] can be created with a supermajority of CHiLL Americans by Total Population [TP] and by Voting Age Population [VAP]. Not once, but three times: 2014 [amber], 2015 [orange] and 2016 [blue]. If I could do it thrice, surely, the PACCD BOT and their agents could have created such a CHiLL American Trusteeship in PACCD if they so wished. Since PACCD did not create a TA with a majority by Total Population and by Voting Age Population [VAP], that shows intent.

I have given the BOT PACCD: 1] US Supreme Court rulings, 2] The Opinion of the Attorney General of the State of California [1991], 3] Ninth Circuit Court decisions, 4] read to them pertinent sections of the California Constitution, 5] call to their attention the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendments to the US Constitution and 6] identified for them the Census Tracts in 1991, 1992, 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016 involved.

It is not for lack of trying to edify the PCC BOT and Audience that I give good counsel to those concern in the service of our great Republic and for the betterment of the College and City which I adore & cherish. We all must strive to fulfill the American Dream and lift all boats for better neighborhoods and neighborliness.

The leadership of the College [PCC] encompasses many individuals: the Superintendent and the Administration, the Board of Trustees, staff and faculty. However, certain persons are charged with specific duties: Dr. Richard Storti as the Assistant Superintendent /Vice President of Business & College Services is the designated official for re-districting purposes. He therefore is included in this correspondence.

Suggestion: The Consolidation of Future Board of Trustees Election with the Statewide Election should be aligned with the November gubernatorial and presidential cycles. While doing Trustee Area Elections with the June primaries would be an improvement over the current odd year elections, it would <u>not suffice</u>. Currently the average age of a voter in Los Angeles County is 68 years of age and the median age in LA County is 38 years of age. Since CHiLL\*American's median age is on the lower end of the age brackets, the timing of election dates is an important factor in their voter turnout. So the November 2018 should be the date of synchronizing with PCC Trustee elections.

The burgundy colored census tract are western Altadena and Pasadena. This was the African American leading TA. The Agua census tracts found in the middle along the 210 Interstate Freeway. The orange census tracts east Pasadena & Sierra Madre. The purple is the Arcadia based TA. The Yellow is made up of South Pasadena, San Marino, and San Gabriel area. The red is the most southern part of the PACCD, it includes El Monte, Rosemead and

part of Temple City. I did not number the TA in this illustrations. The TAs were drawn with the equality of population in mind. So their variance is minute. If I could have block information available, I could demonstrate more innovative results.

In summation, I started this endeavor 25 years ago. I have been extremely respectful to the Board of Trustees and their desires when expressed. With the data now on hand I can offer these observations of this longitudinal study.

- 1] From its origin in 1966, has not followed the California Constitution on the sequential numbering of Trustee Areas on directionality: North to South.
- 2] Pasadena Unified School District has always been dismembered.
- 3] The City of Pasadena has always been sliced up along ethno-racial lines.
- 4] The cracking of CHiLL \* Americans has been a constant theme from 1966 to the present.
- 5] Lake Avenue is the Mason Dixon line of the PACCD, to the determent of CHiLL Americans.
