I have worked as a physician, executive and administrator within the Kaiser system for 23 years. My background training includes law school, medical school and an education degree. I try to use those different perspectives together in complex areas such as quality improvement and risk management. Some of the projects I have been fortunate to lead at work include: reducing the disparities in maternal mortality; working with equity, inclusion and diversity efforts to promote anti-bias training; creating a psychosocial screening tool to screen for domestic violence, substance abuse and depression; training and screening for adverse childhood events; and working with the safe and secure committee on outside threats. I have worked with the Brady Center to end gun violence on efforts to make gun ownership safer. I have worked with Weizmann Day School on a homeland security grant and collaborated with the LA Sheriff on security matters for the school. I worked with the Pasadena Police public affairs liason to set up our Marengo Avenue neighborhood watch.

11. How would you add value to the Community Police Oversight Commission?

I would bring a different perspective of a physician with a legal and educational background whose primary interest is the health and well-being of the community and the police force. I see those as groups as having complementary goals and a strong working relationship between the police and the community as essential to a robust and healthy society. I have been a Pasadena resident for the last 15 years, my children have gone to school here, and I care deeply about the community.

12. What do you see as the objectives and goals of the Community Police Oversight Commission?
Accountability and transparency are the primary goals but they need to go hand in hand with communication and understanding. Building trust and bonds between the police force and the community they serve will make accountability and transparency that much easier to achieve.

13. How would you help achieve these objectives and goals?
I would seek to understand the unique challenges in the police force and in the local communities. Pasadena is not just one thing, it is many smaller neighborhoods joined together each with their own character and concerns. The police need to expertly navigate all of those differences often while entering unknown and risky situations. My background in risk management would lead me to consider ways to de-escalate and make those situations less hazardous for everyone. Less fear all around means a greater chance for understanding and trust building.


