We have received a notice of construction from PWP notifying us regarding the project of installing new underground conduits for a new electrical system upgrade, without any prior notification. As small business owners we are still navigating the uncertainties of a pandemic, have not even recovered half of our lost business due to it, and with a project like this the impact will be devastating for us.

With traffic closures on Shoppers Ln, and the traffic/parking restrictions on Lake, continuous current construction work on Del Mar how are you planning on "not disrupting" our delivery services, and who is going to absorb the loss of business during this project?

Please reconsider scheduling this. We have BARELY survived a pandemic that almost put us out of business 3 times within the last 3 years. The last thing we expect is our beloved city pushing us out of business.
