A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA, CALIFORNIA, SETTING PRIORITIES FOR THE FILING OF WRITTEN ARGUMENTS RELATED TO A CHARTER AMENDMENT INITIATIVE PETITION MEASURE TO IMPOSE RENT CONTROL, CREATE A RENTAL HOUSING BOARD, AND SET CRITERIA FOR JUST CAUSE EVICTIONS ("CHARTER AMENDMENT RENT CONTROL MEASURE"), AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF THE MEASURE

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Pasadena, ("City") to be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at which there will be submitted to the voters of said City a local ballot measure in substantially the following form:
