Our Voices Matter District 3

The selection process by City Council to appoint a representative to fill the open seat for District 3 was flawed on many levels. Based on the results of their selection many City Council Members chose to ignore the voices and wishes of District 3. Brandon Lamar received a total of 89 letters of support sent to Council, of which 44 were from District 3 residents, more than double the number for the next candidate. Also he received 13 speaker card phone call ins. Both the letters and speaker cards cited Brandon's on the ground grass roots community involvement and support for the issues important to the residence of District 3. In addition and in accordance with requirements to be considered a qualified applicant, candidates must gather a minimum of 25 signatures from registered voters in District 3; Mr. Lamar turned in 300 nominating signatures, two to three times the next candidate.

Based on the facts pertaining to the City Council stated selection process, it becomes clear that Brandon Lamar had overwhelming support from not only the citizens of District 3 but citywide as well. Many of the members of the Pasadena City Council chose not only to ignore this support during the selection process but did not take into consideration that Brandon, unlike the other two candidates, had the courage and commitment to put his name in the Democratic Electoral Process. He took his message to the voters of District 3 and was able to receive 41% (1081) of the vote. Yet some members of Council chose to suppress the importance of him running against an incumbent, being outspent by a huge margin and still resulting in surprisingly enormous support from voters of the District.

Some residents of District 3 are meeting not in support of or against any of the candidates that applied to fill the vacant Council position. Rather it is because of

the concerns for long-term, inherent dangers, if the process used in the recent appointment SHOULD GO UNNOTICED AND BE ACCEPTED. MANY OF THE RESIDENCE OF DISTRICT 3 WILL CONTINUE TO CHALLENGE THE PROCESS.

The question is will Councilmembers make a decision based on the priorities of District 3 as decided by its residents. Additionally a change in the Charter is needed for more safeguards against backroom deals that could involve a few members of the Council in plots like THAT WHICH RECENTLY OCCURED IN LOS ANGELES.

Regardless of the Council appointment decision two members, Steve Madison and Jessica Rivas, stated for the record that they considered the vote a rejection of the will of the people of District 3.

Dear Mayor and City Council,

My name is Allison Henry and I am a District 3 resident; resident of and former board member of the Garfield Heights Neighborhood Association. I was also appointed by Mayor Gordo to serve on the Housing Task Force to work on the housing element and am a co-founder of the San Gabriel Valley Tenants' Alliance. This letter is in support of Brandon Lamar for the District 3 appointment to serve the late Councilmember Kennedy's term.

In my opinion, Brandon Lamar is more qualified to equitably represent District 3. Too many residents in our district are struggling and aren't properly listened to at council and I think Brandon Lamar can change that. Brandon Lamar's showing in the last election and the public support he has brought to bear are not being taken seriously enough by the council.

And I am sure that Mr. Jones is a capable human being, but I will state here that I am uncomfortable with the length of time, or lack of length of time, Mr. Jones lived in District 3. Many of us feel that it is so easy for wealthier and connected classes of people to walk into power, and that this council process continues to facilitate that unequitable and harmful process. I hope this can at least serve as a reflection point for the council: *are you selecting someone that your interests want to work with or who actually represents District 3?*

In addition, I suggest considering efforts to change our City Charter so that we have a better process and say for district residents should this situation occur again. We need City Charter amendments that would

a) provide for a special election in the event of a victor's/incumbent's death before taking office and

b) create a better process should the council not be able to vote overwhelmingly for the appointment. Currently, should the Council not be able to reach consensus or majority vote then the seat is filled by a random draw. Random draw is an easy way to break a stalemate but not a just one. I propose that in the event of the Council not being able to arrive at a clear majority winner through a vote that the Council utilize rank-choice voting. A random draw just seems like a whim in the process. We can do better.
