8. What specifically in your background, training, education, or interests qualifies you as an appointee?

Personal: I was born and raised in the City of Pasadena. I come from modest means: my father was a small business owner, and my mother was a homemaker.

My family has been a staple in the Pasadena community, starting with a successful family business: Woods and Valentine's Mortuary. I received my education from Pasadena Public Schools; I played three years of varsity football for Pasadena High School. My first job was a rose program intern with the City of Pasadena Water and Power; and my second job was an engineering intern, during summer and winter breaks, with the Department of Public Works

Civic Engagement: Currently, I represent District 3 on the Pasadena City Council. Prior to serving on the Council, I served on and chaired two commissions in the City of Pasadena: I had the privilege to represent District 3 on the Human Relations Commission; and serve as on the Environmental Advisory Commission. I was asked and appointed by city staff to serve on the Stakeholder Technical Advisory Group for the Power Integrated Resource Plan; and I've collaborated with numerous City of Pasadena Departments: Parks, Recreation and Community Service, Police, Public Works and Water and Power in my role as councilmember, commissioner, and private citizen. During the Safer at Home Order, I partnered with STEAMCODERS to provide free math tutoring services to students who were falling behind during distance learning.

Public Service: I am a licensed Civil Engineer who works for the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works.
