## TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA ADOPTING A MILITARY **EQUIPMENT POLICY** 

### **PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE**

As directed by the City Council on April 25, 2022, this ordinance adopts a military equipment use policy pursuant to Government Code Section 7071.

#### REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

Assembly Bill 481, codified as Government Code Section 7070 et seq., went into effect on January 1, 2022, and requires a law enforcement agency that seeks to continue use of military equipment to "commence a governing body approval process" no later than May 1, 2022, and to have the military equipment use policy adopted by the body (here, the City Council) no later than 180 days of submission of the proposed policy.

AB 481 also requires the City Council to review the ordinance adopting the military equipment use policy at least annually, on a going-forward basis.

In response to the Council's discussion about the policy at its May 23, 2022 meeting, the Police Department has revised the Purpose of the .50 Caliber Precision Rifle (page 7 of the current equipment list, which is part of the policy) to clarify that the primary purpose of this equipment is not for use against individual persons, except if necessary in exigent circumstances.
