The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> This ordinance, due to its length and the corresponding costs of publication, will be published by title and summary as permitted by Section 508 of the Charter. The approved summary of this ordinance reads as follows:
"SUMMARY
The purpose of Ordinance No is to amend the Water Rate Ordinance, Title 13, Chapter 13.20 of the Pasadena Municipal Code as directed by the City Council on March 14, 2022, to implement adjustments to the water rates necessitated by a number of factors resulting in the need for additional revenues, and to clarify the definition of the Capital Improvement Charge.
This ordinance shall take effect upon publication by title and summary."
