**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA, CALIFORNIA AMENDING THE  
WATER RATE ORDINANCE, TITLE 13, CHAPTER 13.20 OF THE PASADENA  
MUNICIPAL CODE**

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** This ordinance, due to its length and the corresponding costs of publication, will be published by title and summary as permitted by Section 508 of the Charter. The approved summary of this ordinance reads as follows:

**“SUMMARY**

The purpose of Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_ is to amend the Water Rate Ordinance, Title 13, Chapter 13.20 of the Pasadena Municipal Code as directed by the City Council on March 14, 2022, to implement adjustments to the water rates necessitated by a number of factors resulting in the need for additional revenues, and to clarify the definition of the Capital Improvement Charge.

This ordinance shall take effect upon publication by title and summary.”

**SECTION 2.** Title 13, Chapter 13.20, Section 13.20.030 A of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.20.030 - Service charges and rates.

**SECTION 4.** Title 13, Chapter 13.20, Section 13.20.035 A and B of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

13.20.035 - Capital improvements charge.

- A. A capital improvements charge ("CIC") shall be added to water rates to recover the capital improvement costs of the water-distribution-system as provided in this section.
- B. CIC Amounts. The CIC rate for Service Area A and Area B shall be as follows and shall be subject to adjustment as provided in subsection C:
