SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PERMITTING THRESHOLDS

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 8 (HEALTH AND SAFETY), CHAPTER 8.80, AND TITLE 14 (BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION), CHAPTER 14.28, OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PERMITTING THRESHOLDS

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

On August 8, 2022, the City Council directed the City Attorney to return with amendments to the Pasadena Municipal Code to amend the regulations regarding the permitting and disclosure of hazardous materials.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

The regulations regarding the permitting and disclosure of hazardous materials are within Titles 8 and 14 of the Pasadena Municipal Code and an ordinance is required to amend Titles 8 and 14.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED

The Fire Department will implement the proposed ordinance.

FISCAL IMPACT

It is anticipated that the Fire Department will have a decrease in revenue by less than \$10,000 annually due to the decrease in the number of hazardous materials permits required.
