

APPROVAL OF IN-PERSON AND REMOTE PUBLIC COMMENT PARTICIPATION AT PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEES, AND SPECIFIED CITY LEGISLATIVE BODIES THAT MEET IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER

February 6, 2023





- Council provided direction on November 21, 2022 to resume in-person public meetings of all city legislative bodies.
- First in-person City Council meeting occurred January 9, 2023. All other bodies resumed in-person meetings.
- Topic of remote public comment referred to EdTech Committee for further discussion.



- Limit remote public comment to only available from the Council Chamber to minimize technology investment and support costs.
- Begin allowing remote public comment for those bodies scheduled in the Council Chamber with active public comment, or as directed by City Council, including:
  - > City Council & Council Committee
  - > Planning Commission
  - > Design Commission
  - > Community Police Oversight Commission



- On occasion, meetings of other legislative bodies may be scheduled in the Council Chamber to allow for remote public comment when there is a high level of public interest anticipated on the agenda topic.
- Resume remote public comment at specified legislative bodies no earlier than February 27, 2023 to allow staff to make necessary preparations and adjustments.

# Remote Public Comment Support Impacts

## Department of Information Technology

- Remote public comment requires most of the remote meeting capabilities and staff resources that were available to support remote meetings of the City Council during the COVID pandemic.
- Summary of resources increased/added to support fully remote meetings:
  - Integration of Council Chamber audio visual technology with virtual meeting technology for simultaneous in-person & remote capabilities
  - > Online Speaker Card queuing and management
  - > DoIT Staff Added two DoIT staff to run virtual meeting technology
  - > City Clerk Additional overtime for two staff
  - > Contract sound engineer
  - > And other capabilities enumerated in Agenda Report
