**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA  
ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE 2022 SB 1205 FIRE INSPECTION REPORT**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1205 (SB 1205) was passed and signed by the Governor of California in September 2018 adding California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.4 (the Code), which outlines the criteria for State Mandated Inspections and reporting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Code requires all fire departments that provide fire protection services to report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with State Mandated Inspections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pasadena Fire Department has identified two thousand three hundred forty-eight (2,348) occupancies that are State mandated for annual inspections and reporting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pasadena Fire Department completed 667 (or 28%) of the 2,348 State mandated inspections for 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Pasadena has discussed and acknowledged receipt of the Fire Inspection Report in compliance with California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.4.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA  
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

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1. That the City Council acknowledges the receipt of the 2022 SB 1205 Fire Inspection Report as outlined in California Health & Safety Code section 13146.4.


