PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

On December 5, 2022, the City Council approved the adoption and amendment of the State codes. The proposed ordinance will correct typographical errors in these ordinance amendments to ensure the accuracy of Chapter 14.04 of the Municipal Code.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

Building code regulations are codified within Title 14 of the Pasadena Municipal Code and an ordinance is required to amend Title 14.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED

The oversight of the building codes is with the Planning and Community Development Department.

The proposed ordinance shall have no fiscal impact to the City.


ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION
