A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA
CHANGING THE NAME OF _____ TO TROOP WAY

WHEREAS, a request was submitted by Ms. Keisha Wilkins for the City to rename a portion of “_____”, which extends from _____ to “Troop Way” to recognize the achievements of a Rhythm and Blues (R&B) group, Troop; and

WHEREAS, affected Public Utility Agencies, the United States Post Office, the Pasadena Police Department, and the Pasadena Fire Department have been notified and have no objection to the street name change; and

WHEREAS, public notices were posted along _____ and sent to affected property owners and published in local newspapers; and

WHEREAS, Section 34091.1 of the California Government Code provides that a legislative body may adopt a resolution designating or changing the name of a street; and

WHEREAS, following the procedures of Chapter 2 of Division 2, Section 970.5 of the California Streets and Highways Code, a public hearing was held to consider the proposed street name change and notice was given prior to the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pasadena as follows:

1. That the public street in the City of Pasadena known as “_____” from _____ should be renamed and is hereby changed to and hereafter shall be known as “Troop Way”.
