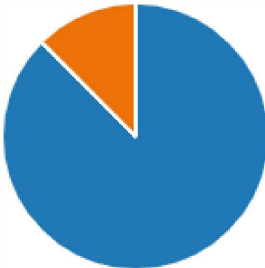

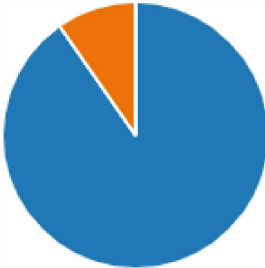
1. Are you a Pasadena resident?

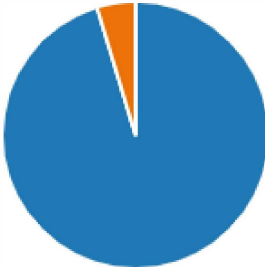
2. Based on what you know, would you say that the City of Pasadena needs additional funding to seismically earthquake retrofit the Central Library so that it can safely be re-opened to the public?

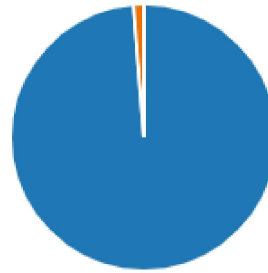
3. Do you agree that it should meet current fire safety regulations?

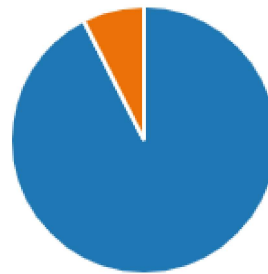
4. Repair and replace the leaky roof?

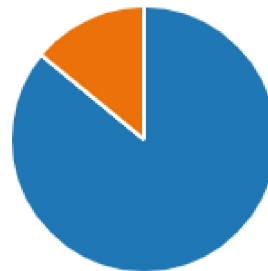

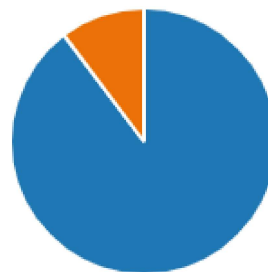

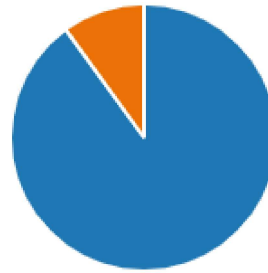

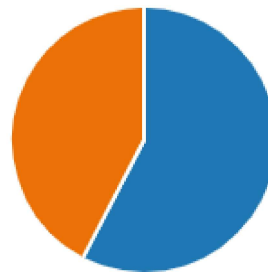

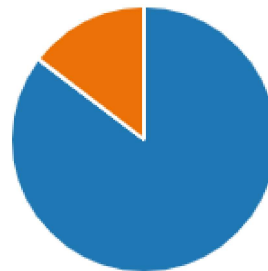

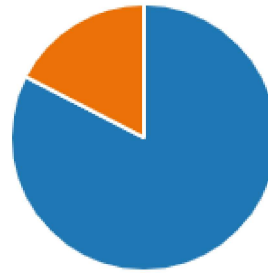
