A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA, CALIFORNIA, SETTING PRIORITIES FOR THE FILING OF WRITTEN ARGUMENTS RELATED TO A CHARTER AMENDMENT MEASURE FOR THE SELECTION OF FIRE AND POLICE TRUSTEES TO SERVE ON THE PASADENA FIRE & POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF THE MEASURE

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Pasadena, to be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at which there will be submitted to the voters of said City a local ballot measure in substantially the following form:

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Pasadena does resolve, declare, determine, and order as follows:

Shall an amendment to Section 1502 of the Pasadena City Charter to ensure continued fire and police representation on the Pasadena Fire and Police Retirement System Board by allowing fire and police trustees to be selected pursuant to a policy approved by resolution of the Retirement Board, be adopted? not exceeding 300 words in accordance with the Elections Code of the State of California, Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9, Sections 9280 et seq., and may be changed until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk, August 16, 2024, after which no arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the City Clerk.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of the measure to the City Attorney. The City Attorney shall cause to be prepared an impartial analysis of the measure showing the effect of the measure on the existing law and the operation of the City. The impartial analyses shall be filed by the date set by the City Clerk for the filing of primary arguments, August 16, 2024.
