New City/County Partnership

- Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health (DMH) awarded \$952,348 to Pasadena Public Health Department through June 2026
- Supports 9.0 Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) positions to implement the United Mental Health Promoter (UMHP) Program
 - > Serve unhoused population in Pasadena and surrounding communities in SPA 3
 - > Provide referrals to mental health, substance use treatment, housing, medical/dental, public benefits, and other services
 - > Provide advocacy and navigation assistance to program participants
 - > Deliver trainings to community members and organizations on Mental Health First Aid and Community Resiliency Model
- Evolution of GEM and TAY Link Programs previously funded by LA County DMH



New Component of PORT

PORT

- Serving only City of Pasadena
- Intensive Case Management
- Support navigation of resources
- Multidisciplinary (PPHD, PFD, Huntington Health, Union Station)

UMHP

- Focused on Pasadena and surrounding communities in SPA 3
- Offer one-time resources and referrals
- Train community members and organizations on Mental Health First Aid and Community Resiliency Model
