CHARTER STUDY TASK FORCE TOPICS REVIEWED

- Vacancy Appointment Process for City Council
 - Council Vacancy Two years or less on term
 - Require appointments
 - Maintain 75-day appointment period
 - Process codified in Pasadena Municipal Code
 - Public engagement and public meetings required
 - 6-month residency in-district required prior to vacancy





CHARTER STUDY TASK FORCE TOPICS REVIEWED

- Vacancy Appointment Process cont.
 - Council Vacancy More than 2 years on term
 - Election required
 - Remaining term filled upon certification of election results once more than 50% of votes achieved for one candidate (either in Primary or General/run-off election)
 - Remove "chosen by lot"
 - If Council cannot meet 75-day appointment deadline, special election occurs
 - Add death as part of the definition for vacancy



CHARTER STUDY TASK FORCE TOPICS REVIEWED

- Vacancy of Mayor, Role/Appointment of Vice Mayor
 - Mayor Pro Tem position
 - Serves during vacancy until position filled by election
 - Chosen by remaining members of City Council
 - Requires five votes
 - Allow City Council to call special election if more than two years remain on term of Mayor
 - Vice Mayor
 - Chosen on annual basis
 - City Council Organizational meeting
 - Chosen on a rotational basis
 - Consider seniority





CHARTER STUDY TASK FORECE TOPICS TO BE REVIEWED

- Mayor and City Council Term Limits
 - Discussed at February 7th meeting
 - Scheduled for follow-up on March 14th
- Timing of Election of Mayor
 - Discussed at February 22nd meeting
 - Scheduled for follow-up on March 28th
- Council Compensation Issue Scheduled for March 14th
- Campaign Contribution Limits Schedule for March 28th
- April and May meetings
 - Finalize topics
 - Prepare Final Report to the City Council
 - April 11th meeting to occur at Robinson Park Recreation Center
 - May 9th meeting to occur at H&H Jivalagian Youth Center
