TITLE OF PROPOSED UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 2, ARTICLE I, CHAPTER 2.05, SECTION 2.05.060 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE THE REGULAR MEETING TIMES FOR THE CITY COUNCIL

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

There is interest in starting regular meetings of the City Council at 5:00 p.m.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

This legislation is needed because Pasadena Municipal Code Section 2.05.060 requires that the City Council conduct its regular meetings on Mondays at 5:30 p.m. An uncodified ordinance was adopted in March 2021 to change the regular meeting time to 4:30 p.m., and the Council has followed that since the uncodified ordinance was adopted. There has been some discussion about possibly moving the start time of regular City Council meetings to 5:00 p.m. to accommodate schedules. In order to conduct its regular meeting start time to 5:00 p.m.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED

The City Clerk's Office will implement the proposed ordinance.
