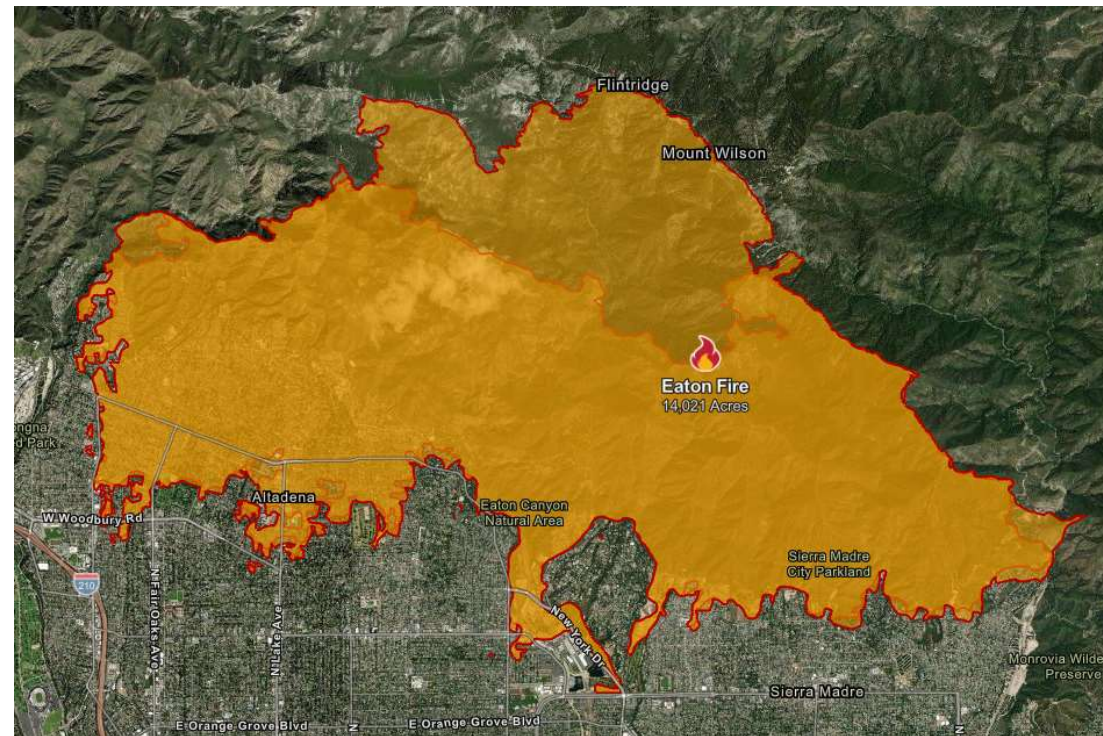

- 98% containment
- 3,408 total Firefighters assigned
- 9,418 structures destroyed
- 1,073 structures damaged
- 17 civilian fatalities



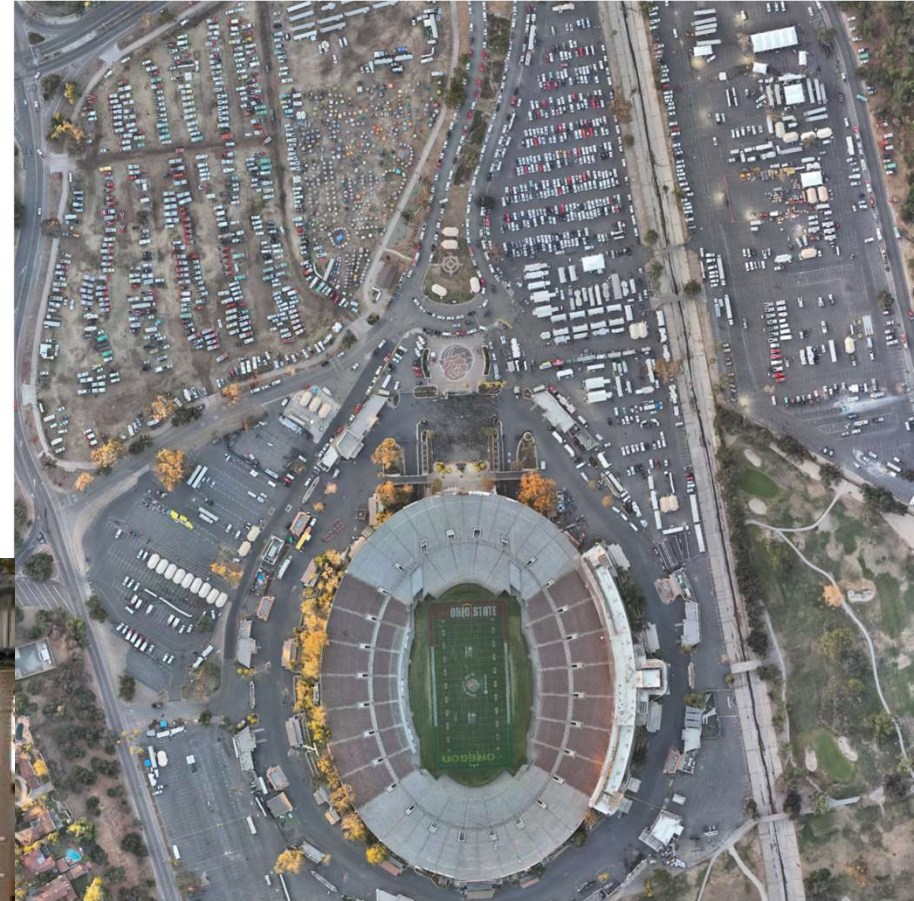

- PWP resolved all do-not-drink tap water orders
- Thousands of Sandbags
- Cleaned out detention basins
- Installed 2,000 linear feet of K-rails in high-risk areas
- Ongoing green waste clean up
