BACKGROUND

Police Department

- The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant has awarded \$34,390 to lease automated license plate reader cameras (ALPR).
- The grant was awarded for technology that would assist with investigations, deter crime, and prevent crime. A further recommendation was for technology that could be used regionally.
- Pasadena Police department (PPD) has identified the need for ALPR cameras.
- The need is in alliance with our mission of increasing public safety through technology.



BACKGROUND

HOW DOES ALPR TECHNOLOGY PREVENT & ELIMINATE CRIME?

- PROACTIVE:
 - > Real-time alerts to LE when stolen vehicle or fugitive vehicle is detected within our city.
 - > Real-time alerts to LE when vehicle associated to abducted / missing persons are detected within our city (Amber / Silver Alerts) – provides LE the ability to react quickly to save a life.
- INVESTIGATIVE:
 - > provides critical information that will generate almost immediate actionable leads; leads that can result in quick apprehensions and the recovery of crucial evidence.

- DETERRENT:



- 2022 - \$43,434
 - > X-ray machine for vehicles
 - > Fentanyl test kits
