Shared Goals & Community Commitments

- Provide safe, welcoming spaces for youth across the City & District, ensuring consistent supervision & supportive environments before school, after school, & during summer months.
- Promote healthy engagement & enrichment, offering programs that build social-emotional skills, physical wellness, & positive peer connections.
- Expand access to educational & developmental opportunities that reinforce learning, spark curiosity, & support the whole child.
- Maximize shared resources & facilities through coordinated planning, joint use agreements, & collaborative problem solving that benefit families & the broader community

After School Adventures Program (ASAP)

- Serves students ages 4.5 - 13 yrs at 10 PUSD Schools & at Victory Park Recreation Center
- Consists of homework time, outdoor play, youth sports, cheerleading, & enrichment classes

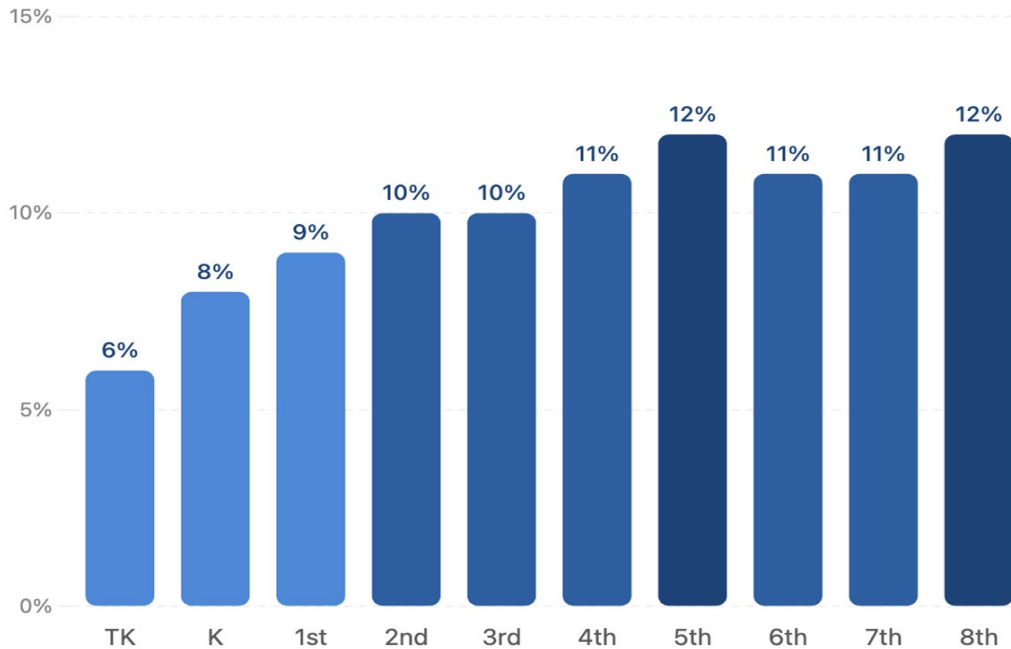

TK-8th grade students enrolled — by grade level

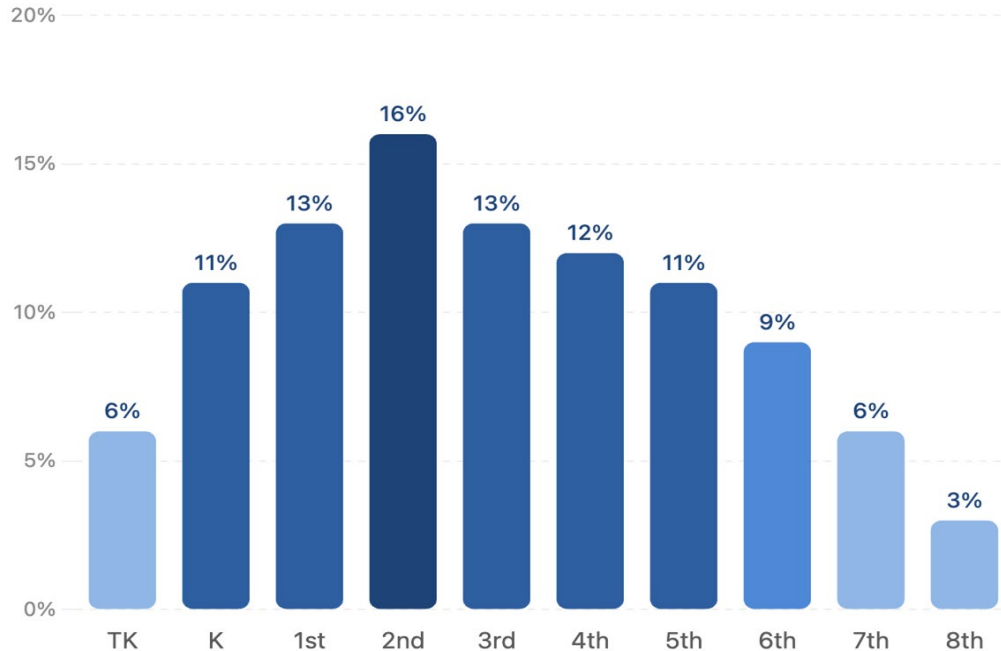

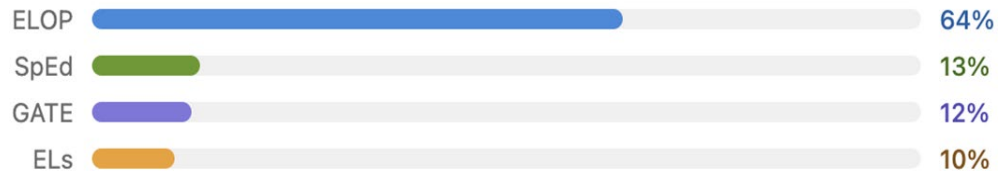
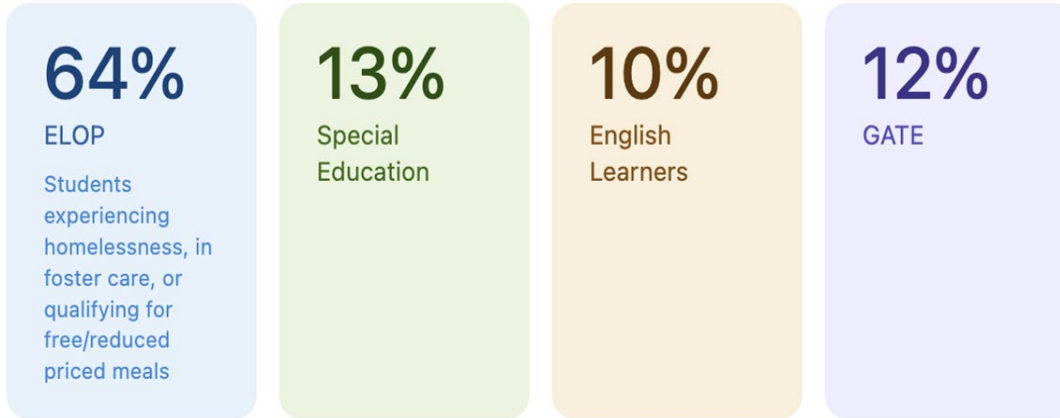

TK–8th grade students enrolled in 2025–26 school year programs

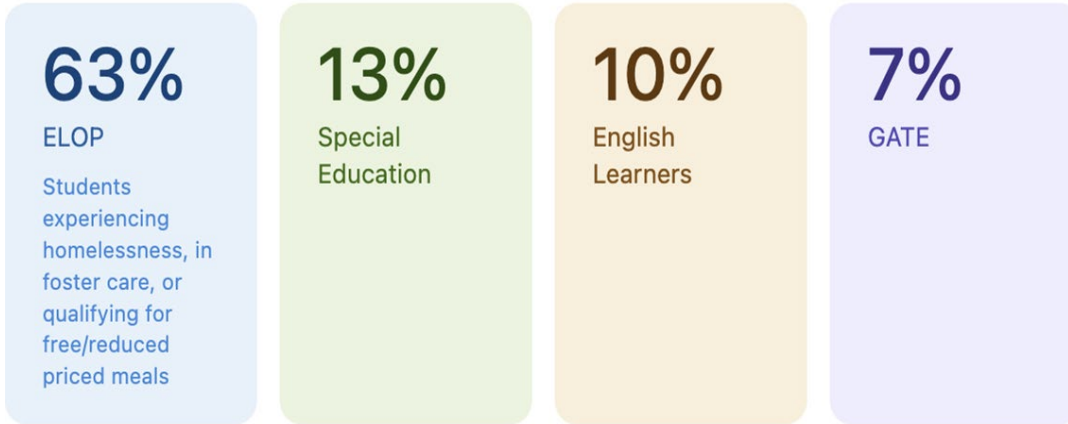
