Subject: Stub recovery governance: City Council must govern

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City Manager and Council Persons:

The Freeway Stub recovery project must be governed by the elected representatives of the whole City. Seventy years after we began resistance to the 710 Freeway through Pasadena, led by the City Council, we now have the chance to manage our victory and undertake the largest project in City history.

Outsourcing management to a small unrepresentative and unskilled committee risks political capture by a small group, uninformed decisions, and diversionary emphasis on issues unrelated to the development.

For me, though redlining throughout America has had tragic effects, efforts to find and pay the descendants hurt by the legal processes of 70 years ago distracts from managing needed development and breeds conflict.
