13. Commission and Operating Companies Term Limits and Training

There has been much discussion about making special concessions for term limits for the operating companies like the Rose Bowl.

While commissions receive part time support from City staff, the operating companies on the other hand have entire teams of staff including a chief executive officer, and a general manager and a senior director of operations, with collective salaries in the *millions*.

Is the rationale really that despite several full time staff which collectively make millions that any particular board member is instrumental and essential to the success of operating companies? Then why not hire them?!

Let's recall that RBOC is an entity which is eligible to apply for and receive federal grants, yet it has left money sitting on the table....despite the hundreds of thousands of dollars spent on consultants to search for new streams of revenue – including recommending RBOC go after said federal grants.....where was the help of this extremely seasoned and long-tenured board?

In addition, there seems to have been a communication breakdown and misalignment of goals between RBOC and partners like UCLA, costing the city more time and resources in litigation....

Lets not gloss over the facts as the council discusses baking in special exceptions for the operating company boards.
