Dear Mayor Gordo and Councilmembers,

On behalf of the Jewish Federation of the Greater San Gabriel and Pomona Valley (Federation), we write regarding a proposed modified Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) policy that, we understand, the Legislative Policy Committee is recommending for adoption by the Council. While we understand that the proposed revised ESG policy does not include an anti-Israel Boycott, Divest and Sanction (BDS) component, we anticipate that the BDS activists who have repeatedly appeared at City Council meetings –irrespective of the meeting agendas—demanding that you adopt an anti-Israel investment policy will seek to modify or interpret the new ESG proposal to advance their BDS campaign.

Federation has taken an active position opposing Pasadena adopting a BDS policy since the issue first surfaced last year. We have written letters,¹ provided the council with background information (March 2025), appeared at public hearings and encouraged public comment reflecting our objections to ensnaring the City of Pasadena in a matter of foreign policy; i.e., the Gaza war between Israel and Hamas following Hamas' barbaric attack on Israel, including civilian communities and gatherings, on October 7, 2023 (October 7).² We have made parallel arguments directly to the Pasadena Fire and Police Retirement Fund (Retirement Fund), urging its board to comply with its fiduciary duties and reject any country-specific, non-economic driven divestment policy.

We are gratified that, as we understand it, the Council will be considering a modified ESG policy (with respect to which Federation takes no position) that omits any direct or indirect reference to Israel. We hope this approach will finally bring the Pasadena BDS campaign to its long-overdue conclusion. We are constrained to anticipate, however, that the anti-Israel activists will still seek to interpret any new ESG policy statement, irrespective of its actual language, as license to argue that BDS is alive and well. **We therefore urge the Council to go on record in voting on any new ESG policy that it does not apply in any respect to divestment or any other adverse action pertaining to any foreign country, explicitly including Israel.**

This submission is not intended to burden you with the full arguments contained in our written and oral presentations to date. Instead, we hope this summary will be helpful to provide you in one place the various points we have made to you in opposing BDS. Again, we apologize to the extent this letter addresses matters that you have already resolved.

1. The war in Gaza (now hopefully at an end) and the overall conflict between Israel and the Palestinians is beyond the scope of the duties of local government, including Pasadena's. Even if the war did somehow implicate the interests of the residents of Pasadena, which it certainly does not, it would be impossible for the Council to devote the time and resources (human and financial) to develop an independent and reasoned position to justify taking sides against Israel and adopting a BDS policy. In the absence of an appropriate independent investigation, the policy could be viewed as arbitrary and capricious.
2. Singling out the world's only Jewish state for derision and delegitimization—and that is exactly what BDS would be—is unthinkable in the existing atmosphere where antisemitism has skyrocketed. In 2024, 80% of all religious based hate crimes in Los Angeles County were directed against Jews.³ Those who dismiss the antisemitic underpinnings of the anti-Israel movement should study the photo of the vandalism at the remains (following the Eaton fire) of the Pasadena Jewish Temple and Center (PJTC), included in PJTC's February 5, 2026 letter to the Commission opposing any BDS policy.

As PJTC's letter sets forth so eloquently, it would be devastating to the Pasadena Jewish community for the Council to adopt a policy that effectively demonizes Israel and seeks to exclude it from the family of nations. Quoting from PJTC's letter:

When anti-Israel rhetoric gets normalized, it provides a permission structure for those who hold violent antisemitic feelings to act. This makes anyone who supports Israel (which, again, includes 80-90% of all Jews) an acceptable target for hatred and violence. By cloaking evil with "ethics," it gives those who wish to do harm license to do so.

We, as a Jewish community, are asking you not to contribute to that.

The impact of a BDS policy would go beyond the Jewish community. Concern for Israel, and an expectation that the Council would adopt a hostile stance towards the Jewish state, a key U.S. ally, only where somehow necessary based upon an exacting record, includes people of all faiths. There is no such record.

3. Regarding the governance issues involving any BDS action by the Council (or the Fire and Police Retirement System Board), we urge the Council to take careful account of the Department of Finance's December 18, 2025 "Agenda Report" to the Legislative Policy Committee regarding adoption of an ESG policy. The Agenda Report, quoting a "White Paper" developed by the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission, states,

Since the City's policy must comply with the State Government Code, as outline above, any consideration of SRI [Socially Responsible Investing] or ESG strategies must be able to balance the desired objectives with a local agency fiduciary responsibility and statutory investment limitations. . . . "[T]he statute provides no authority to agencies to sacrifice principal preservation and maintenance of necessary liquidity to SRI objectives."

The balancing process referred to by the Finance Department cannot be based on adopting hotly contested claims vexing the international community that Israel is committing genocide against Palestinians.

While stated somewhat ambiguously in its concluding section ("Fiscal Impact"), the Agenda Report assumes that any divestment initiative is a non-starter:

Any changes to the Investment Policy should not have a material effect on the City's investment performance as the California Government Code prohibits and changes to the policy that would sacrifice principal preservation and the maintenance of liquidity.

The Retirement Fund's investment advisor, Versus Advisers, was more direct in its advice to the Retirement Fund at its Board's November 19, 2025 meeting:

Versus' general thought on divestment is that it limits the opportunity set. This limitation tends to lead to either increased risk, lower market returns or both, particularly when it is concerned with a single industry or sector. Additionally, divestment or other investment decisions based on non-economic factors are not considered to align with the fiduciary standard.

While the Retirement Fund and the City are subject to different statutory mandates, the principle of prioritizing fiscal responsibility over political or foreign policy considerations or purely symbolic condemnations of a foreign government is the same. This is particularly so given the intense disagreements over the allegations against Israel giving rise to the divestment movement.

4. The State of California has adopted laws and policies rejecting BDS. (See AB 2844 and Cal. Public Contract Code 2010. Also see Legislative Policy Committee's December 18, 2025 Agenda Report (page 34)). While these provisions may not bar Pasadena from adopting BDS against Israel, any such action would be hostile to clearly articulated state policy. How could this be in the interests of Pasadena residents, particularly in the absence of an unambiguous record?⁴
5. While beyond the scope of Federation's expertise, we nonetheless question not only the wisdom but the potential legal implications of the Council intruding upon the foreign affairs

of the U.S. government—because boycotting a close U.S. ally would be exactly that. We assume the Council would explore this potential issue with its counsel.

6. The Legislative Policy Committee's December 18, 2025 Agenda Report (page 33) discusses Pasadena's 1988 divestment from South Africa and highlights the differences between that experience and divesting from Israel. Indeed, when Pasadena divested from South Africa, the City acted in conformance with state and federal divestment policies existing at that time. In fact, federal law imposed mandatory federal sanction on and prohibited new U.S. investment in South Africa. There is nothing remotely comparable today with respect to Israel. The legal and political environment is to the precise opposite.

Additionally, comparing apartheid South Africa to Israel is ludicrous. Contrary to South African apartheid, Israel is a multiethnic parliamentary democracy whose Arab citizens participate fully in civic, professional, and political life—the anthesis of the system of forced racial segregation and political exclusion that defined apartheid. Arab-Israelis vote in all elections, hold seats in the Knesset (parliament), sit on the Supreme Court. Approximately 17% of Israel's physicians are Arab-Israeli as are 24% of its nurses and nearly half of its pharmacists. Arab-Israelis constitute approximately 20% of the students at Israel's world-renowned technology school, The Technion. Any comparison between Israel and apartheid South Africa only proves the absurdity of applying the South Africa example to Israel.

To the extent the Council has already determined not to proceed with any anti-Israel divestment policy—as we hope and believe to be the case—we are sorry to have burdened you with arguments you have already considered and resolved accordingly. This letter, however, reflects the deep concern of the Jewish community that Pasadena could conceivably adopt a policy that would alienate and ostracize the overwhelming majority of its Jewish residents. We know this is the last thing the Council would ever intend, and it is for that reason that we are reiterating the essential reasons why the Council should now put this matter to rest and say so explicitly.

Thank you for your patience and your service to our community.

Honorable Mayor Gordo and City Council of Pasadena,

PURPOSE OF OUR LETTER

We are your constituents and deeply concerned Americans who, like you, care profoundly about our beloved city and country.

Sadly, our city now finds itself at the forefront of a runaway train.

We are writing to bring your attention to the calculated manipulation and coordinated propaganda campaign behind the pressure for a proposed (direct or indirect) reference to BDS or Israel on any proposed Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) resolution or any other City policy. These tactics falsely accuse Israel of genocide.

If applied consistently and universally, it would demand sanctions against numerous governments and armed groups responsible for well documented atrocities.

Yet, its laser focus on Israel reveals its true hand - selective enforcement disguised as morality to isolate Israel, a staunch democratic ally.

We ask you to read this letter, reject terrorist ideology, refuse to give this resolution any oxygen, and vote for our democracy instead.

HAVE YOU EVER WONDERED....

Is a 'social justice' movement legitimate if...?

- 1) It pays 'protesters' using funds linked to U.S. designated terrorist groups? [1-3]
- 2) Its followers harass, intimidate, vandalize, are violent, and even murder fellow Americans? [4]
- 3) It shuts down civil discourse and intimidates people who dare to disagree? [5]
- 4) It demands civil rights protections for itself but violates the civil rights of fellow Americans - including a protected minority? [6]
- 5) It rebrands a terrorist attack as 'resistance'? [7]

- 6) It ONLY condemns one country, and is silent while its compatriots in different countries are doing ACTUAL atrocities (e.g., slaughter of protesters in Iran; slaughter, rape, and enslavement of Black Christians in Nigeria and Sudan; lack of gender equality in many Muslim majority countries)? - 7) It calls for anti-Black racism in America while perpetuating Black racism in many Muslim majority countries (e.g., Libya, Mali, Mozambique, Niger, Somalia, Sudan, UAE) ? [13-20]
- 8) It uses silence or rebranding to justify rape against Jewish women? [21]
- 9) It uses coalitions with civil rights groups (e.g., Black Rights, Communists, Feminists, LGBTQ+ Community) that it vehemently disagrees with to broadcast its ideology and then abandon in the future? [22-23]
- 10) It calls for the discrimination, exclusion, and intimidation of fellow university students? [24]
- 11) It bullies city councils and boards to vote on isolating a democratic ally that protected and rescued its citizens after experiencing a terrorist attack and simultaneous attacks on seven fronts against its diverse citizens on its 3,000-year-old indigenous land? [25-26]
- 12) It demands that Americans abandon their moral reasoning - the bedrock of democratic values? [27]

Additionally, have you ever asked yourself....?

How could thousands of students in 520 American universities, a day after 10/7/23, all chant the exact same chants, repeat the same libelous accusations on and off-line, hold the same banners, and use identical strategies for campus take overs? [28]

AHA MOMENT

Have you figured it out? This is not 'social justice.' It is an authoritarian movement dressed in sheep's clothing.

It is the fruit of a Master Plan, entitled The Memorandum (1991), comprehensively designed by the notorious Muslim Brotherhood (MB) (a designated terrorist organization in Bahrain, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, UAE; and in the U.S. - Lebanese, Jordanian, Egyptian branches). Upon translation, the FBI discovered a shockingly sophisticated plan for a "civilizational jihad" to take-over the United States and destroy it from within [29-30].

The document states:

"The Ikhwan [The Brotherhood] must understand that their work in America is a kind of grand jihad in eliminating and destroying Western civilization from within and sabotaging its miserable house by their hands and the hands of the believers so that it is eliminated, and God's religion is made victorious over all other religions" [31].

Rather than using overt violence, the MB uses sophisticated strategies to embed multi-layered extremist Islamist ideology in the U.S. - keeping peaceful Muslims, and all diverse people who speak against this ideology, silent with reputational and financial intimidation, vandalism, and violence [32].

FOUR LAYERS OF ENTRYISM IN THE USA

The Memorandum meticulously outlines four major strategies that weaponize our democratic freedoms (e.g., free speech, civil rights, lawfare, etc.) to embed an intolerant ideology with the aim of destroying our democracy.

1) POLICY IMPACT: Islamists achieve consultative government positions to obstruct our country's response to counterterrorism and shift foreign policy. In a wiretap, the FBI discovered that CAIR is a front for the MB - Hamas - in the U.S. Post September 11th, CAIR has played a strategic role in removing counter-terrorism training about Islamist extremism in Department of Homeland Security manuals [33-34].

2) LEGAL FRAMEWORK MANIPULATION: Islamists turn debate about their ideology and violent behavior into claims of discrimination to protect their totalitarian agenda [35].

3) INSTITUTIONAL INFILTRATION: Islamists build networks of schools, charities, Islamic chairs, campus and off-campus organizations to transmit their ideology under the radar of those unaware it is propaganda meant to destroy the host democracy. The Muslim Students Association (MSA) is in 600 U.S. colleges, there are 300 Islamic Centers in 42 U.S. states, and U.S. professors, such as Cornell's Russell Rickford, call the Hamas terrorist attack "exhilarating" [36-37].

4) NARRATIVE CONTROL: Islamists influence media, education, and academia, using financial investments and media partnerships to promote MB ideology and spokespersons. Qatar, a state sponsor of terrorism, has spent over \$100 billion across U.S. Congress, lobbyists, colleges, PR firms, corporations, and media [38-39].

BDS: MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD'S SECRET WEAPON

BDS, and related methods falsely accusing Israel, are an essential part of the MB's "civilizational jihad"[40].

Like other totalitarian movements, the MB needs a rallying cry, so it wraps its intolerant ideology in 'social justice' language to create messaging palpable to Western ears. By rallying against Israel, the MB pretends to sell Americans 'social justice' but in reality, it fools Americans into amplifying its violent extremism and warped moral code [41]. Yes, the MB wants to eradicate Israel, but its ultimate goal - is to take down the USA - the seat of DEMOCRACY in the world and replace it with extreme, intolerant Islamism via "civilizational jihad" [42].

BDS: INFRASTRUCTURE TO AMPLIFY TERRORIST IDEOLOGY

The goal of BDS campaigns is not merely to pressure cities to adopt terrorist ideology that ultimately tries to shape U.S. foreign policy.

The true power of BDS lies in its role as a permanent, embedded organizational infrastructure across America -- one that can be rapidly mobilized against American cities during future global crises to fool and pressure the public into aligning with MB terrorist ideology [43].

Our city's decision regarding this proposed discriminatory BDS is a test case for how deeply we allow or block this infrastructure from taking root. Choose wisely.

MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD ALIGNED GROUPS

It is essential to carefully look at the groups that are pushing for this proposed resolution in our city. The Memorandum lists 29 initial groups embedded in the USA that are carriers of the MB totalitarian ideology (see reference # 44). Moreover, the Memorandum mentions the importance of building alliances with groups (e.g., Black rights, Communists, Feminists, LGBTQ+, etc.) whom the MB vehemently disagrees with and will abandon in the future - but intentionally uses to broadcast MB's terror messaging [45].

BDS: FALLING INTO THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD'S TRAP - A THREAT TO DEMOCRACY AND SOCIAL HARMONY

Even entertaining a BDS resolution in the hallowed halls of our city government plays right into the MB's hands - threatening our laws and the security of our communities.

The U.S. Constitution's Commerce Clause grants only Congress the power over foreign policy and sanctions - not cities. This proposed resolution risks unconstitutional overreach and undermines the rule of law [46-47].

Moreover, there is a direct correlation between divestment campaigns such as this and the increase of discrimination, harassment, and violence against Jewish citizens [48-49].

After the Pasadena Jewish Temple was vandalized with antisemitic graffiti, and antisemitic hate crimes in California have jumped by 57% compared to pre-10/7 incident numbers, why would your governing body risk the liability of generating more antisemitism and potential violence against our Jewish community members? [50-51]

Why would you entertain BDS that ultimately violates our Constitution, threatens the civil rights of our children and neighbors, and rips away at the peaceful fabric of our society?

FALSE ACCUSATION

It is ludicrous to have a resolution falsely accusing Israel of genocide.

As in previous wars that Hamas has started, Hamas leaders finally admitted that they lied about numbers of civilian casualties, and that 72% of casualty numbers were male terrorists [52-53].

Other reports, however, show that 86% of casualty numbers were male terrorists [54-56].
There was NO genocide here.

CONCLUSION

Now you are on record for learning about the Islamist game plan. The MB's original document is a must-read [57-58].

Will you dare wade into international waters or wisely focus on your defined role in city governance?

This proposal to reference BDS or Israel in an ESG resolution or any City policy falsely accuses a democracy, is discriminatory, and does not promote justice - it institutionalizes selective outrage.

It replaces universal principles with a totalitarian ideology that values intolerance and violence - opposing the democratic principles of our city and country.

This proposed (direct or indirect) reference to BDS and/or Israel risks repeating history's most familiar error: mistaking moral language for moral action.

We urge you to indefinitely REJECT the proposed libelous resolution.

Our city and our genuine commitment to human rights demand better.

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Council Member,

I am writing to urge you to support and expand the ethical investment resolution scheduled to come before council on May 11th. As a Pasadena community member, it is very important to me that our tax dollars are spent in alignment with our values as a community. How we spend our money is a direct reflection of our values, and I want to see our spending promote human dignity, freedom, and respect for the planet and all of its people.

I wholeheartedly support the council's decision to prohibit investments in weapons manufacturers, fossil fuel companies and private prisons. And I urge you to go beyond this language, and to align the resolution with Pasadena's stated commitment to protecting our immigrant neighbors by prohibiting investments in companies engaged in mass surveillance. If we are divesting from the private prisons incarcerating our immigrant community members, we should be divesting from the machinery that allows the government to target, surveil and kidnap them. I also hope you will include language about divestment from genocide, specifically naming the genocide in Palestine that our tax dollars are currently funding. Just as Pasadena has acknowledged the Armenian genocide, so should the council acknowledge the human rights atrocities that our government has funded and supported. I don't see how genocide and ethical investment could ever be compatible.

I applaud you for taking this important step to more fully articulate a citywide ethical investment policy. I hope you will take the draft resolution from the Legislative Policy committee and expand on its important premise so that Pasadena can truly have an ethical investment policy that reflects the values of this community I treasure.

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Dear Members of the Pasadena City Council,

I write to you regarding the proposed expansion of Pasadena's Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) investment policy, which will appear on the agenda at the April 13, 2026, council meeting. I urge the Council not to include any language referencing the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) movement or singling out Israel—directly or indirectly—in this policy.

Pasadena holds no direct investments in any of the companies being targeted by proponents of BDS. This campaign has no economic significance for the city. Rather, this effort is clearly designed to delegitimize and malign the world's only Jewish state. Singling out Israel, or any other country, has no place in local governance.

Introducing a divisive political issue into municipal policy, one that does not serve Pasadena residents, would be inappropriate and counterproductive.

Furthermore, BDS does not advance peace. It fuels conflict, harms the very people it claims to help, and undermines the cooperation between Israelis, Palestinians, and their allies that any lasting resolution requires.

Including such language in city policy would send a troubling message to the Jewish community in Pasadena and throughout Southern California regarding their sense of inclusion and representation in local governance. It also risks marginalizing residents whose identity and heritage are closely connected to Israel and contributes to the alarming rise in antisemitic rhetoric and violence across the country since October 7, 2023.

Pasadena's city government should remain focused on local priorities and the well-being of its residents—not on international conflicts that fall outside its scope and responsibility.

Therefore, I respectfully urge the Council to clearly state on the record that it will not adopt any BDS-related measures or policies that single out Israel or any other country.

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I am writing to urge the Council not to include any reference to BDS or to Israel—directly or indirectly—in any proposed ESG resolution or other City policy.

Municipal policy should remain focused on matters directly affecting the residents and governance of Pasadena. Singling out the world's one Jewish state for sanction or condemnation has no meaningful connection to the City's responsibilities and unnecessarily imports divisive international political disputes into our community.

Any action to promote BDS, directly or indirectly, would also send a troubling signal to members of Pasadena's Jewish community and beyond. Policies that single out Israel will be understood as marginalizing and alienating Pasadena Jewish residents whose identity and heritage are often closely connected to Israel.

Moreover, normalizing anti-Israel rhetoric and sentiments through municipal policy risks contributing to the broader climate where antisemitic rhetoric and even violence have skyrocketed.

I respectfully urge the Council to state clearly on the record that it will not consider adopting any BDS resolution or policy—directly or indirectly—and that Pasadena will not single out any specific country in the world for sanction through City policy.
