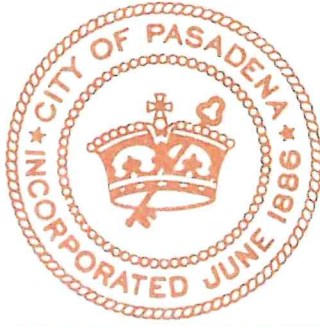

**SUBJECT: 2026 LOCAL AGENCY BIENNIAL NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS
TO THE PASADENA CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE**

RECOMMENDATION:

This 2026 Biennial Notice of Amendments to the City's Conflict of Interest Code is submitted for information purposes only.

BACKGROUND:

The Political Reform Act requires the City's Conflict of Interest Code, adopted by Resolution No. 10107, to be reviewed every other year. Upon review of the Code, the City Council must be informed whether revisions are required in the City's Conflict of Interest Code, the nature of the required revisions, and the approximate date such revisions will be made.

After review of the City's Conflict of Interest Code, it has been determined that an amendment by means of a resolution is required. The appendices to the resolution must reflect new positions, deleted positions no longer required to report, revised titles of existing positions, revised disclosure categories, and deleted titles of positions that have been eliminated. These revisions will be submitted to the Council by the end of December 2026.

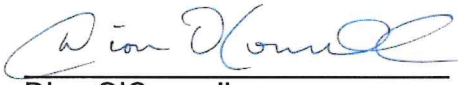
FISCAL IMPACT:
