**SUBJECT:** Authorization to Issue a Purchase Order Contract to D & S Fueling,

Inc. for the Fabrication and Installation of Four Fuel Island Canopies for the Public Works and Transportation Department

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council: i) accept the bid dated June 28, 2000 submitted by D & S Fueling, Inc., in response to specifications for the Public Works and Transportation Department, ii) reject all other bids and iii) authorize the Purchasing Administrator to issue a purchase order contract to D & S Fueling, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$124,867.00.

## BACKGROUND

This project provides for the installation of fuel island canopy covers and lighting at all existing city owned fuel islands, i.e. the City Yards, the Police Department, Fire Station #33 and the Civil Defense Center. In order to meet State and Federal Regulations, all fueling systems are required to be covered to prevent the accidental discharge of petroleum products into the storm drain system in the event of rain.

On June 15, 2000, a Notice Inviting Bids was published in *The Pasadena* Journal. In addition, specifications were sent to fifteen businesses on the Purchasing Division's vendor list and posted on the City's web page. Three responses were received and opened in the City Clerk's office on June 28, 2000.

The bid results are as follows:
