TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING SECTION 2.175.030 (A) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY MANAGER, OR REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ROSE BOWL OPERATING COMPANY

BACKGROUND:

This ordinance would effect the automatic appointment of the City Manager to the Board of Directors of the Rose Bowl Operating Company, or her representative, without the need for further City Council approval.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

The proposed ordinance will amend the Rose Bowl Operating Company Ordinance so that the City Manager or her authorized representative shall be appointed without the need for ratification by the City Council. The City Manager's authorized representative would serve at the election of the City Manager upon written notice to the City Clerk.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:


The Pasadena Municipal Code may only be amended by ordinance of the City Council.
