It is recommended that the City Council reject all bids to purchase police uniforms and personal property.


BACKGROUND

Specifications for the purchase of police uniforms and personal property for the Pasadena Police Department were issued on September 23, 1999. Four responses were received and opened in the City Clerk's office on October 19, 1999. The Police Department has determined that the uniform requirements for the non-sworn personnel have changed and that the original specifications issued no longer adequately apply. The Specifications are being revised to conform to the changes and to allow for the department to enter into a multi-year contract to provide for future uniform and personal equipment needs.


FISCAL IMPACT




