AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING  
SECTIONS 2.05.160 (B), 2.05.170 (B), 2.05.180 (B), 2.05.0190 (B), AND  
2.05.200 (B) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING  
THE COMPOSITION OF CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES

The People of the City of Pasadena do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Subsection B of Section 2.05.160 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The finance committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

**SECTION 2.** Subsection B of Section 2.05.170 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The business enterprise committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

**SECTION 3.** Subsection B of Section 2.05.180 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The legislative committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

**SECTION 4.** Subsection B of Section 2.05.190 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The public safety committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

**SECTION 5.** Subsection B of Section 2.05.200 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The deregulation committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


