AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING SECTION 3.24.110(A)(23) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING A SUNSET CLOSING TIME AND A DAWN OPENING TIME FOR NATURAL PARK AREAS IN THE ARROYO SECO.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3.24.110(A)(23) of the Pasadena Municipal Code is amended to read as follows, in its entirety:

"23. To loiter or remain in the Lower Arroyo, as depicted on Drawing No. 3575 on file in the department of public works, or in the Hahamongna Watershed Park as depicted on Drawing No. 4787 on file in the department of public works, at any time from dusk to dawn. To loiter or remain in any other public park at any time between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following morning."

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its publication.


