Subject: Authorization to Extend Contract No. 16,462 with General Pump Company Inc. for Deep Well and Pump Maintenance for the Water and Power Department, Specification WD-97-02

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the General Manager to extend Contract Number 16,462 with General Pump Company Inc., for a final term of one year or until an amount not to exceed \$350,000 is expended, whichever occurs first, pursuant to Specifications WD-97-02, Deep Well and Pump Maintenance for the Water and Power Department.

Background

On August 18, 1997, the City Council authorized the General Manager to enter into Contract Number 16,462 with General Pump Company Inc., for the furnishing of all necessary labor, materials, equipment, transportation and services for deep well and pump maintenance necessary during the regular course of water system operation. The term of the contract was for one year with two optional one year extensions subject to the approval of the City Council. The City Council approved the first one-year extension on December 7, 1998. Water and Power wishes to extend the Contract for the last optional one-year extension period.

As provided for in the Specifications, the Contractor has submitted a proposal requesting a price increase of 2.4% which is equal to the current increase in the Consumer Price Index to offset the additional cost of labor, equipment and expenses for the period from December 1999 through December 2000. Throughout the current contract period, General Pump Company Inc.'s performance and timeliness in completing work has been satisfactory. The Department proposes the Contract Amendment not-to-exceed amount to be \$350,000.


