It is recommended that the City Council reject all bids to purchase a mobile shelving storage unit for the Pasadena Police Department property room.


BACKGROUND

Specifications for the purchase of a mobile shelving storage unit for the Pasadena Police Department property room were issued on November 12, 1998. Three responses were received and opened in the City Clerk's office on December 8, 1998. A review of all bids revealed questions as to the responsiveness to the specifications by all bidders. The Police Department in conjunction with the Purchasing Division determined that new specifications would be developed and reissued on a later date.

FISCAL IMPACT


The cost of reissuing and rebidding the specifications is negligible.






