TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA GRANTING NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISES FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION TO 48 APPLICANTS.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

On April 26, 1999, the City Council held a public hearing on each of the forty-eight (48) applications for non-exclusive solid waste franchises. All applications were subsequently approved by the City Council which directed the City Attorney and staff to prepare the necessary ordinance for the approved applications and authorized the City Manager to enter into the franchise agreements on or after the effective date of said ordinance.

#### REASONS WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Charter of the City of Pasadena, Article XI, Section 1104 specifies that the procedure for granting a franchise shall be by ordinance.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The continued assessment of an 11% franchise fee on hauler's gross receipts provides approximately \$650,000 in annual revenue to the City of Pasadena. City of Pasadena, Resolution Number 6860 (February 9, 1993) states the following with respect to revenue collection and expenditures for this program, in pertinent part:

"Section 3. Each monthly franchise fee payment shall be calculated as 11% of the gross monthly receipts received in the preceding calendar month. Fifty percent (50%) of the franchise fee payment shall be paid to the City general fund. Fifty percent (50%) of the franchise fee payment shall be placed in a special fund account to be used only for costs stated in Public Revenue Code Section 41901 or any successor provision for preparing, adopting, and implementing an integrated Solid Waste Management Plan."


ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

The Environmental Administrator has determined that the proposed ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), which states the following: "[t]he activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA."







ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA GRANTING NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISES FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION TO 48 APPLICANTS.

WHEREAS, on March 15, 1999, the City Council of the City of Pasadena considered applications for non-exclusive solid waste collection franchises and, after determining that said applications appeared to comply with Chapter 8.61 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, adopted Resolution No. 7722 declaring the intention to consider the granting of said non-exclusive franchises; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution was duly published on April 15, 1999, and;

WHEREAS, a duly-noticed public hearing pursuant to said Resolution was held on April 26, 1999 on the applications; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing each application, and after public hearing, it was determined that specific applicants comply with Chapter 8.61 of the Pasadena Municipal Code.

NOW THEREFORE, the People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:
